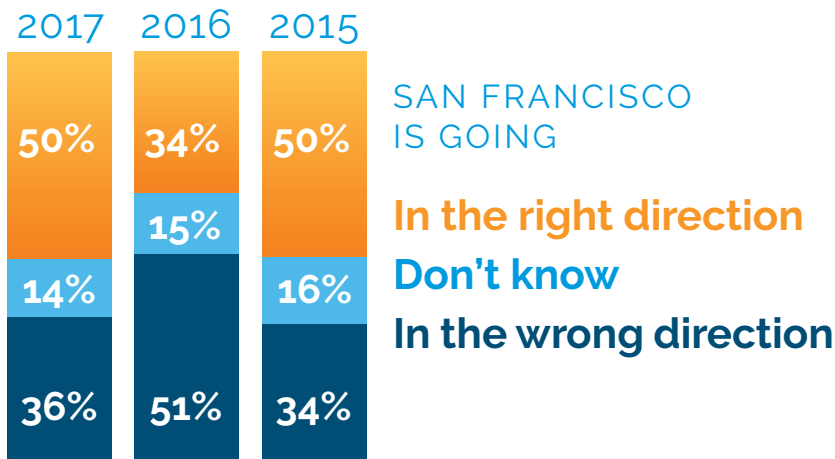


CITYBEAT POLL RESULTS

San Franciscans feel their city is back on the right track. They are generally content with the services provided, and with the programs that seek to reduce homelessness and increase housing density. However, voters remain very concerned about the increasing cost of living and the shortage of affordable housing. They support a dedicated sales tax for transportation and transit while split on the merits of various SFMTA projects. They overwhelmingly support the city's sanctuary city policy, giving tasers to police officers, as well as navigation centers for the homeless, while opposing a suggested 2017 special election.

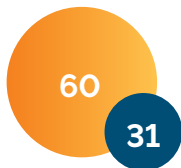

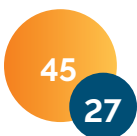

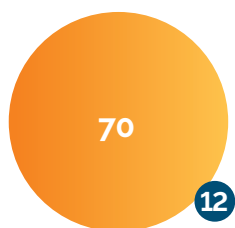

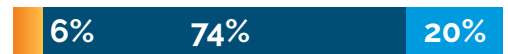

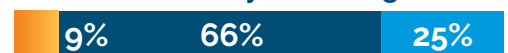
